Such justice of the peace shall, if he finds the proof sufficient, Application of fines, impose the fine with costs, which fine wholly belongs to the prosecutor, if he be a game-keeper. and one half only if he do not act in an official capacity; in the latter case the other half is paid over to the game keeper for the division, to belong to him.

In default of immediate payment, the offender is imprisoned in the common gaol of the district within the limits of which the offence was committed or in which the seizure and confiscation were effected, for any period of time not exceeding three months, and, in cases of infringement of article 1404, for a period not exceeding six months.

Every justice of the peace has power to convict on view. Seizures, confiscations and prosecutions are at the risk of the Scizures, &c., at person who caused the same to be made or carried on. 47 V., c. 25, s. 14; 50 V., c. 16, s. 13; 59 V., c. 20, s. 6.
