Express Companies Notify News Agents They Will Stop Traffic Beginning To-Day. Hamilton, March 8.—(Special.)—Commencing to-morrow, Hamilton's supply of American Sunday papers, which have been sold openly and delivered on Sunday, will be shut off. The express companies have notified the newspaper agents that no papers will be carried by them. Last Sunday the express companies brought papers into the city, but the newsboys who handled them got into trouble with the authorities.
