PROTECT HOME CONTRACTORS. Yankees Should Be Shut Out Whe G.T.P. is Built.

"Why should United States contracters enjoy privileges in Canada not en-United Straes?" asked a prominent contractor of The World yesterday, referring to the Grand Trunk Pacific project and the investigation now proceeding concerning the allegation that American engineers have been employed by the Grand Trunk to the disadvan-tage of home brains.

They have a statute in the United States barring aliens from competing with United States contractors, and we are prevented by this statute from tendering on the work of the enlargement of the Eric Canal, for which a vote of \$101,000,000 has been made by the State of New York. A few years ago Connolly Bros. were shut out of the Philadelphia harbor improvements, the reason given being that they were foreigners. Their tender was about \$125,000 below that of the next lowest tenderer. "When we fail to produce enough contractors in Canada, as they say we did in the case of the engineers, then there can be no objection to allowing foreigners to come in. If the Canadian people are to pay for the railway they ought to be given the preference when the money is being paid out for the construction of the railway. If the Yankees are allowed to come in, a large slice of government money will be taken over the border to promote American prosperity.
