**FOUR SAILORS CREMATED
IN BURNING OF STEAMER**

"City of Collingwood" a Total Loss
at Northern Port—G. T. R.
Freight Sheds Destroyed.

Collingwood, June 19.—A disastrous fire broke out on the steamer City of Collingwood at 2 o'clock this morning, which burned the vessel to the water's edge, and rapidly did the work of the crew, and wiped out the Grand Trunk freight sheds before it was subdued. Several other members of the crew had a narrow escape, and had to jump into the water, and were rescued by the fire department. Those who were killed were: James Meade, fireman; Lyman Peters, Owen Sound, deck hand; A. McEllan, Owen Sound, deck hand; and J. D. Montgomery, second mate, and Capt. Wright, who had just left the boat a short time, was at his home. He made desperate attempts to save his life, and succeeded in getting out of the boat, but he was killed by the flames. CITY'S CASE LOOKS STRONG

IMPORTANT EVIDENCE TAKEN

The inquiry into the alleged non-compliance by the Street Railway Company with the timetable prescribed by the city was entered into in earnest yesterday. The two witnesses held, after a week ago, were preliminary in character, and consisted almost entirely in the submission of statistical evidence previously tabulated, covering the 181 days from May 1 to Oct. 31, 1904. The company has conceded the accuracy of the testimony advanced by the inspectors, and the city has taken the evidence of non-observance, and the line of defence that now seems to have been adopted by the railway is a confessed inability to abide by Mr. Rust's recommendations.
