\$5,000 FOR CAPTURE OF THE DYNAMITERS

Ottawa, Aug. 17.—An order-in-council has been passed by the cabinet authorizing a reward of \$5,000 for the capture and conviction of the miscreants who recently dynamited Lord Atholstan's summer home at Cartierville.

Announcement of the passing of the order was made by Hon. C. J. Doherty, who said that every possible effort was being directed to hunting down the men who made this attack upon Lord Atholstan's home.

"We cannot afford to allow any such outrage to pass unpunished," said Hon. Mr. Doherty. "Since if it were to pass off without stringent efforts to apprehend the criminals, other efforts in the same direction might follow. It is not a matter of which any publicity is desired, but I can assure you that the full efforts of all the authorities, both Dominion, provincial and others, are being directed to hunting down the men who made this attack upon Lord Atholstan's home. The offering of this substantial reward will probably aid in running them down."
