

DISCIPLINE.

Students presenting themselves for admission are required to furnish proof of their good character. If coming from another college, a certificate, given by the authorities of that institution, will be required.

On entering the college, they are supposed to accept its rules, and will be required to observe them faithfully. Semi-annual reports are sent to parents, respecting progress, conduct, etc.

Every student must wear a uniform, consisting of a blue coat with white seams, and a sash.

Students are not allowed to go beyond the college grounds without special reasons, and, as a rule, never alone.

Their correspondence is subject to the inspection of the Director.

Books, papers, periodicals, etc., are not allowed to them, until examined and sanctioned.
