Scarcity of fresh eggs sent the best stock up close to record figures, while some advances was established in high-grade butter and cheese was very firmly held. Quotations on iron and steel continued to recede, and weakness again predominated in the minor metals, tin being especially easy. Announcements of further price concessions in textiles was not expected and the yielding in hides and leathers has been extended, although there is hardly enough buying power to really test the market, and prices are more or less unestablished. In rubber, the reactionary tendency has continued.
