Cardinal Mercier DELAYS HIS VISIT TO AMERICA

New York, July 3.—Cardinal Mercier is so occupied with ecclesiastical duties that his anticipated visit to the United States will not be made sooner than September, according to Abbe Julius E. De Von of Chicago, who was one of the passengers to arrive here on the Lorraine from Havre. Abbe De Von, who was sent by the archbishop of his diocese to persuade the Belgian prelate to bring it back to normal.

Andrew Parker Nevins, a New York lawyer, returned on the steamer after a tour of Europe as a member of the Commission of Industrial Relations of the National Civic Federation. Mr. Nevins said that when he left Vienna, Austria, the populace was facing a food famine, and there was little hope of alleviating the conditions under the present reactionary regime. Horse meat was selling in the butcher's shops at \$2.25 a pound, the lawyer said. Commercial and economic conditions were chaotic.
