New York, Oct. 2.—It is announced here that the delegates of six international unions in the building trades have completed forming an alliance by which strikes over disputes involving the work one union should do will be averted.

The six unions are the Bricklayers and Masons International Union, the Journeymen Stone Cutters International Union, the International Union of Engineers, the United Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners, the Plaster and Ornamental Operative Plasterers Society and the International Hod Carriers and Building Laborers Society of America. They represent more than 200,000 workers throughout the United States and Canada.

CATHOLIC CHURCH
AND EMPIRE'S WAR

Le Conflict of Truly Christian Principles Against Recrudescence Paganism

SAYS ARCHBISHOP BENSON

Thinks Italy Should Take a Hand in War and Believes She Will if Voice of the People is Heard

(Montreal Gazette Cable) London, Sept. 29.—Interpreting for the world at large the sentiment of English Roman Catholics toward "this conflict of truly Christian principles against recrudescence paganism," Mr. Robert High Benson, in a special interview at the Archbishop's Palace at Westminster tonight said that it was impossible to imagine any Catholic in the world, who knowing the truth, would doubt which forces were on the right side. Archbishop Benson expressed the strong hope that the United States would remain neutral because of the great power as a peacemaker it would have at the conclusion of the European struggle. "However," he added, "I suppose in sheer self-defence the Americans would join us if the allies should be beaten. But they won't be."

The archbishop sees grave danger in Germany by the disapproval of German Catholics at the barbarities attributed to the Prussians, as already exemplified in the reported indignation of the Bavarian troops over the action of the German troops in Belgium.

He feels that Italy should take a hand in the war on the side of the Allies. "And she will, too," he said, "unless the voice of the people fails utterly to be heard by the government."

Why Not With Austria?

At the first glance, Mr. Benson observed, it appeared as if Catholicism was Catholic in all except union with Rome. And what is called Russia's semi-civilization looms up as almost sublime in comparison with the crimes committed in the name of Prussian culture. Surely no true follower of Christ can fail to realize that the Allies are fighting against recrudescence Paganism!

"The war is not all evil, by any means. Think what it has done for Britain already. It has knit Britons together more closely than perhaps they were ever before. It has silenced the accusations of English decadence. It has even sent crime down with a tremendous rush. There may have been a case against the Boer war, but there has never been a suggestion of one against the part we are playing in this war."

"How extraordinary the sight, and yet how natural to one who knows Irish character, to find Catholic Ireland united with Protestant Ireland in absolute unanimous approval of Britain's move. But Ireland has always been sound at heart in the face of a big crisis."

"How do English Catholics feel about Louvain and Rheims?" the Archbishop was asked.

"We are so furious that it is difficult for us even to think about those acts of diabolical destructiveness. Yet we know that such incredible vandalism was only expected from a people which boasts of its paganism, as clearly shown in Bernhardi's book, which professes openly to regard priests as symbols of Christianity."
