RESOLUTION ON BOOK ROOMS.

Whereas, it is desirable that Baptists in the Dominion should be united in the support of a Publication Society for our common country, and

Whereas, the Standard Publishing Company, of Toronto, is a Baptist organization with large capital,

Therefore Resolved, that we express our conviction that it would be desirable for the Baptists of this Association and the Maritime Provinces to ask the above Society to take into consideration the propriety of establishing a branch of its business in these Provinces, and that should it do so we will pledge it our sympathy and support.

An interesting discussion followed, in which Revs. W. E. McIntyre, W. J. Stewart, Dr. Hopper, Dr. Welton, G. E. Good and Bro. G. J. Coulter White, spoke at considerable length.

Resolution adopted.

Resolved that the Minutes be printed to the amount of moneys received, and that Rev. W. E. McIntyre and Bro. T. D. Denham be a committee to attend to the publication.

Resolved that the thanks of this Association be tendered to the press for the reports given of the proceedings of each session.
