Nothing of the Sort.

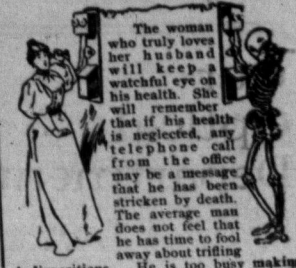
