

MacEWAN Reg. No. 13497, ex-S/Sgt. Allister MacEwan, 77, died May 10, 1996, at Victoria, B.C. He was born November 5, 1918, at Westville, N.S., and joined the Force June 29, 1940, at Halifax. Upon completion of training at "Depot" Division, MacEwan was posted to "O" Division, Ont., at Toronto, North Bay and Timmins. He was subsequently transferred to the following locations: February 2, 1948, to "A" Division, at Ottawa and Cornwall; June 1, 1949, to HQ with the RCMP Gazette, then on May 1, 1961, as **Editor of the RCMP Quarterly magazine**. MacEwan retired December 7, 1966. He was promoted to corporal November 1, 1957; sergeant November 1, 1961; staff sergeant May 1, 1965.

MINOR Reg. No. 17788, ex-Sgt. Douglas Harold Minor, 89, died May 17, 1996, at Regina, where he was born January 19, 1907, and joined the Force November 9, 1932. Upon completion of training at "Depot" Division, Minor was posted to "K" Division, Alta., at Edmonton. On June 15, 1934, he was transferred to "F" Division, Sask., at Saskatoon, Regina, Swift Current, Assiniboia, Carlyle, Willow Bunch, Weyburn, Estevan, Milestone, Bengough, Radville, Torquay, Avonlea, Bromhead and Crane Valley, taking his discharge November 8, 1942, to join the Canadian Army. For his service during the Second World War, Minor was awarded the Canadian Volunteer Service Medal and the War Medal 1939-45. He reengaged into the RCMP on May 15, 1945, at Regina, and was posted to "F" Division, at Regina, Kelvington and Melville. He retired August 25, 1958. Minor was promoted to corporal October 1, 1949; sergeant December 1, 1954.

Ex-Sgt. Minor's son-in-law, Reg. No. O.1228, Supt. Robert Leatherdale, is presently serving as the "F" Division Criminal Operations Officer, at Regina; his grandson, Reg. No. 41600, Cst. Toddd Leatherdale works at Burnaby Detachment, "E" Division, British Columbia.

MOS Reg. No. 19926, ex-Cst. Leo Alex Mos, 56, died July 5, 1995, at Edmonton, Alta., where he was born January 18, 1939, and joined the Force April 16, 1957. Upon completion of training at "Depot" Division, Mos was posted to "F" Division, Sask., at St-Walberg, Radisson, Meadow Lake, North Battleford, Wilkie, Lloydminster, Saskatoon and Goodsoil. On July 1, 1962, he was transferred to "G" Division, at Dawson City (Y.T.), Inuvik and Aklavik (N.W.T.), then he was posted to "K" Division, at Edmonton, and took his discharge March 26, 1963.

O'KEEFE Reg. No. S/1786, ex-S/Cst. Allan Richard William O'Keefe died May 20, 1995, at Quebec City. He joined the Force as a special constable September 13, 1939, at Vancouver, O'Keefe

was posted to "E" Division, B.C., where he worked at Vancouver and took his discharge July 2, 1942.

PEARCY Reg. No. 25408, ex-Sgt. Clifford Frederick Percy, 49, died March 14, 1996, at Calgary, Alta. He was born December 17, 1946, at Edmonton, and joined the Force January 23, 1967, at Victoria, B.C. Upon completion of training at "Depot" and at "P" Division, Mynarski Park (Alta.), Percy was posted to "O" Division, Ont., at Milton, Windsor, Kitchener and Toronto. On November 15, 1975, he was posted to HQ and took his discharge July 16, 1984. Percy was promoted to corporal February 1, 1976; sergeant June 17, 1980.

PERRY Reg. No. 16812, ex-Cpl. William John Henry Perry, 73, died June 17, 1996, at Alert Bay, B.C. He was born November 26, 1922, at Assiniboia, Sask., and joined the Force January 26, 1951, at Victoria, B.C. Upon completion of training at "Depot" and "N" Divisions, Perry was posted to "E" Division, B.C., at Vancouver and North Vancouver. He was subsequently transferred to the following locations: July 17, 1953, to HQ; January 3, 1955, to "K" Division, Alta., at Lethbridge, Manyberries and Medicine Hat; July 15, 1957, to "E" Division, at Cloverdale, White Rock and Victoria, retiring April 3, 1977. Perry was promoted to corporal November 1, 1965.

PERRY Reg. No. S/9701, ex-S/Cst. Kenneth Robert Perry, 75, died April 5, 1996, at Halifax, N.S. He was born January 15, 1921, at Point Clyde, N.S., and joined the Force as a special constable September 19, 1947, at Halifax. Perry was posted to "Marine" Division, aboard the *MacBrien*, *French*, *Fort Pitt* and *Irvine*, taking his discharge April 13, 1951.

PYE Reg. No. 16406, ex-Sgt. Donald Harry Pye, 86, died May 25, 1996, at North Vancouver, B.C. He was born December 31, 1909, at Hibden Bridge, in Yorks, England, and joined the Force August 15, 1950, at Vancouver, upon the amalgamation of the B.C. Provincial Police, where he had been serving since December 22, 1940. Pye was posted to "E" Division, B.C., at Nakusp, Trail, Victoria, Prince George, Kimberley, Cranbrook, Powell River and North Vancouver, retiring December 21, 1965. Pye was promoted to corporal April 1, 1953; sergeant April 1, 1960.

Ex-Sgt. Pye received the following awards from the Most Venerable Order of the Hospital of St-John of Jerusalem: September 11, 1956, the Priory Vote of Thanks; November 7, 1959, the title of Serving Brother; June 24, 1965, the title of Officer Brother. On September 26, 1955, Pye was also awarded the Bronze Medal for Bravery by the Royal Canadian Humane Association for assisting his two travelling
