

a foundation of stone or brick, or if in the Suburbs, a fence of such materials, or of stakes perpendicularly fixed, or boards at least five feet high; and every person so offending shall also forfeit and pay five shillings for each and every day that shall elapse, after he or she shall have been ordered by the said Surveyor to conform to this Regulation, until such order be complied with; provided that within eight days immediately following, that where such line shall have been so drawn, it shall be lawful to any person or persons to complain of the operation of the said Surveyor, by a petition in writing to the Justices, in any of the Special Sitzings, setting forth the causes of such complaint. And the said Justices, after hearing the parties, shall give their judgment on the petition.

ART. 3. Every proprietor or occupier of lots of ground in the City or Suburbs, shall inclose or fence in the same, or cause them to be inclosed or fenced in, on each and every side where such lots may be adjoining any square, street, lane or road, with a stone or brick wall, or a palissade erected on a foundation of such materials, or a fence of stakes perpendicularly erected, or boards, at least five feet high, and to keep the said wall, palissades or fence in good repair, under the penalty of five shillings for each and every day, that shall elapse after such proprietor
