**BILL.**

An Act to amend the Act authorizing the Quebec Turnpike Road Trustees to acquire Dorchester Bridge and to make certain Roads.

**W**HEREAS the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign and intituled, "*An Act to authorize and enable the Trustees of the Quebec Turnpike Roads to acquire and assume the possession and property of the Bridge called Dorchester Bridge and for other purposes,*" has not attained the object the Legislature had in view, which was the immediate purchase of Dorchester Bridge and the speedy completion of the Roads mentioned in the said Act, and it is therefore necessary to amend the said Act: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

That for and notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Act above cited, the Quebec Turnpike Road Trustees are authorized forthwith after the passing of this Act, to cause the Roads mentioned in the said Act to be made in the order therein designated, and to expend in making the said Roads the sum of £15,000. currency out of the twenty-five thousand pounds currency which they are in the said Act empowered to borrow, the balance of £10,000. being to be employed in purchasing and improving Dorchester Bridge.

The Roads mentioned in the said Act to be made forthwith.
