
Ottawa, 22nd February, 1911.

Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 13th instant, with which you forwarded a cheque for \$25.00; and in reply I beg to say that this amount together with the \$285.00 forwarded under cover of your letter of the 31st December last, have been credited in connection with Leases 309 and 270 respectively.

Further explanations are required from you with regard to the date when you received \$310.00 from Mr. J. Cobban. You should state why the amount did not appear in your copy of cash book for the month in which the said sum was paid to you. You made a statutory declaration a month to the effect that the statement submitted was a copy of your cash book and a statement of all moneys received by you for and on behalf of Indians. In view of this fact, the Department requires an immediate explanation.
