It was represented to the Department that the Indiana who held this property outside of the reserve de sired to have it transferred to the Grown to become a part of their reserve and all that seemed to be necessary was a conveyance to His Majesty, if on the report of your AS. there appeared to be no encumbrances or adverse claims. Although the conveyance under which this prope was held by the Indiana named Kilnah and James Chil who h may not show it, it appears that these two Indians must i held this land as trustees for the Indians of the band.
