DECLARATION

The Court declare that No.C.21715, Pte **Queenville, L., Cameron Highlanders of Ottawa**, on strength of **5 Canadian Infantry Reinforcement Unit**
illegally absented himself without leave from **Tourney Barracks, Farnborough, Hants**

at 2359 hrs on the 27th day of November, 1943,
that he is still so absent, and that on the 10th December 1943 he was deficient, and
that he is still deficient of the following articles—
