Notice here the phrase "First of all, I delivered unto you." Now this scripture is very precious because it shows us just what Paul preached first; it gives us his starting point, his first lesson. From Athens he had gone down to Corinth where the Lord told him He had "much people" (Acts xviii: 10), and there he preached and taught for a year and a half. Some years after this he writes to these Corinthian people reminding them of what he had FIRST taught them. What was it? " Christ died for our sins." You see it was a message that met their need, for were they not sinners before God? Have you. dear reader, taken your place before God a sinner?

"All have sinned and come short of the glory of God" (Rom. iii: 13). If you turn to Luke xviii you will read there of one who took his true place before God. His very brief prayer is given in v. 13.
