thave freely and voluntarily resolved to give and grant unto the King's Most Excellent Majesty the several Rates and Duties hereinafter men-'tioned, and do therefore pray Your Excellen-' cy that it may be enacted ;' And be it enacted Supplies granted by His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Council and Assembly in General Assembly convened, and by the Authority of the same, That from and after the First Day of April next, there be granted to the King's Most Excellent Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, for the Use of this Province, and for the Support of the Government thereof, the several Rates and Duties hereinafter mentioned, on the following Articles which may be imported or brought into this. Province either by Sea, Inland Navigation, or by Land ; (that is to say, )

For every Gallon of Rum, One Shilling;

For every Gallon of Molasses, One Penny; For every Pound of Coffee, One Penny;

For every Gallon of Shrub, Santa, and Lime-Juice Six Pence:

For every Hundred Weight of Brown or Muscovado Sugar, on the Quantity mentioned in the original Invoice, allowing Twenty five per Cent. for Tare and Wastage, Two Shillings and Six Pence:

And for every Pound of Loaf Sugar, Ons Penny;

And in Addition to the Rates and Duties already imposed by the Means and Power of any · Act or Acts of the Imperial Parliament, or under and by virtue of this Act, the following Rates and Duties shall be granted as aforesaid ; (that it to say,)

For every Gallon of Brandy, One Shilling -and Ten Pence:

And for every Gallon of Whiskey, Hollands, Geneva, and Cordials, One Shilling and Six Pence ;

to defray the Expenses of the Government of the Province, by Daty on
