THE sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency (but not Sub-Agency) on certain conditious.

Duties—Six months' residence upon and ultivation of the land in each of three tears. A homesteader may live within the miles of his homestead on a farm of at east 80 acres, on certain conditions. A abitable house is required except where esidence is performed in the vicinity. In certain districts a homesteader in good tanding may pre-empt a quarter-section long-side his homestead.
