### Old Time Taffy-Pull Best Hallowe'en Fun

Some Good Recipes for Youthful Candy-Makers to Try.

There is perhaps no other form of Hallowe'en festivity which creates as much genuine fun for all, and little extra work for the hostess, as an old-fashioned "taffy pull." In issuing invitations, and for an informal affair of this nature, it is better to extend them verbally, request the girls to wear washable waists and old skirts, and the boys to come in their second-best suits. Anyone who has ever participated in the joys of taffy-pulling will appreciate the wisdom of this.

Some good taffy recipes are given below:

**Molasses Taffy**—Boil 1 quart of New Orleans molasses for 30 minutes in a large pan, so that it will run over, stirring constantly; then add half a teaspoon of baking soda and boil it to the "crack" degree; add 1 teaspoon of lemon juice and pour it into shallow, well-greased pans or on a platter to cool; when partly cool, it may be marked into squares or pulled to a golden color. This candy is nicer still if walnut meats are added.

**Everton Taffy**—To 1 pound of cream sugar add 1 teaspoon of water, cream

one-quarter of a pound of butter, and when the sugar is dissolved, stir it in; flavor with a little vinegar, and when cooled, pull the "crack" degree, turn it into greased pans, break off into squares when nearly cold.

**Honey Candy**—Take 2 cups coffee A sugar, water enough to dissolve it, and 4 tablespoons of strained honey; boil until fairly thick, drop in cold water, stir in some nut kernels, and pour it to cool in greased pans, or instead, omit the nuts, and pull.

**Caramels**—Take 4 cups of brown sugar, 2 cups New Orleans molasses, half a cup milk, 2 cups Baker's chocolate (grated fine), and butter the size of an egg; stir all together, and boil slowly over a slow fire until it cracks when dropped in cold water, add vanilla flavor and turn it about half an inch deep into large flat, well-greased tin; when nearly cold, mark it deeply into squares with a greased knife. Break apart when cold and wrap in waxed paper.

In pulling the candy, have the hands well greased or some blistered skin will result.

**Home Hints**

**SAVES THE ROLLER.**

If a piece of sheeting or blanket is sewn tightly round the worn roller of a wringing machine, it saves the clothes from being marked or torn.

**COOLING JELLIES.**

To cool jellies stand the jelly mold in a bowl of water in which a handful of salt and the same of soda has been thrown.

**TO KEEP EGG YOLKS.**

When eggs are not required for immediate use, put the yolks in a basin and barely cover with cold water. Place a plate on the basin to exclude the air. Stand in a dark cool place until required for use.

**SKIM THE FAT.**

After boiling a piece of ham or bacon, the butter should be allowed to stand until cold and then skimmed for the fat. Press the water from the fat. It can be used for making pastry.
