AT WASHINGTON PARK.

Chicago, June 30.—The Englewood stakes, valued at \$2,500, were won by St. Catalina at Washington Park this afternoon. The winner was off last, and after trailing the field to the last turn was sent to the front and won, ridden hard by Miss Gussie, a rank outsider. Uarda ran a good race, and finished third, while Sarabande, the winner of the Latonia Oaks, was fourth. Two track records were shattered to-day by Kentucky Colonel, who went 1 1/2 miles in 1:13. Simon W. ran a great race, scoring a mile in 1:28, and the time for the other races was as fast in proportion.
