The Committee on State of the Order presented the following report, which was adopted:

The Committee on the State of the Order have great pleasure in reporting their belief, that a healthy and progressive spin has continued to characterise the operations of the Subordinst Divisions of this Province.

They regret to learn, that promptness and punctuality do main all cases, characterise the operations of the Deputy G. W. P. of the Subordinate Divisions; and that inconvenience, in may instances, results, in consequence of the Quarterly Returns me being punctually forwarded to the G. S. at the close of extracted guarter. Though this is a matter which occasion regret, yet the Committee feel, that it is an evil which is comparatively of small magnitude; and that a mere referent thereto, will be sufficient to arouse those otherwise efficient valuable officers of the Order to a more punctual attention the duty in the future.

The Committee feel an increasing conviction that the stead progress of the principles of our Order, and the ultimate real zation of the triumph of Temperance principles in our Province must mainly depend on the individual efforts of every members of the Order, whether private or official; and those effet steadily and perseveringly applied. Faithfulness to duty show be the motto of every Son of Temperance. Every neglect duty, on the part of a brother, injures the cause to that extend This fact will be at once self evident to every reflecting india dual. Let brethren, then, and especially official brethren, m become weary in well doing. Whatever neglect and sympton of indifference to the systematic and punctual discharge duties in connection with the working and progress of t Order, as well as the general spread of Temperance principle have hitherto been manifest, let the past more than suffice, a let the future be characterised by a largely increased amount zeal in behalf of the general Cause.

Your Committee highly approve of the proposition for tholding of a Convention, chiefly composed of ministers of the Gospel, at Halifax, on the 4th of August next. We feel that strongest conviction that good results must necessarily followed a meeting.
