Finally, it should be noted that this Agreement was concluded in a spirit of co-operation and great cordiality and that to this end its final version took into account the concerns expressed by both Parties during the negotiations. This is another example of Canada's efforts to protect and conserve the fisheries in its coastal waters while taking into account the economic difficulties that these foreign fishermen might have if their long-standing operations were halted too soon and too suddenly.
