

other House, the particular order in which the motion relates shall stand resolved but without prejudice to the making of a further order of a like nature in relation to a subsequent supplementary convention between the Government of Canada and the Government of Spain, Republic of Liberia, Republic of Latvia, Republic of Lithuania, Republic of Romania or the Republic of Honduras or a subsequent supplementary agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of Jamaica.

(8) Where a motion taken up and considered in accordance with this section is not adopted by the House of Parliament in which it was introduced or is adopted, with or without amendments, by that House but is not concurred in by the other House, the particular order in which the motion relates shall stand resolved immediately on the failure to adopt the motion or upon the failure to concur in it.

(9) For the purposes of subsection (1) and (2), "sitting day of Parliament" means a day on which either House of Parliament sits.

(10) When each House of Parliament meets, it shall, subject to any resolution made by that House, refer to the subject-matter of a resolution of both Houses of Parliament any motion or amendment thereto which is referred to that House in accordance with section 29 of this Act in the manner provided in an order made by the House of Parliament.

(11) For the purposes of subsection (1) and (2), "sitting day of Parliament" means a day on which either House of Parliament sits.

(12) For the purposes of subsection (1) and (2), "sitting day of Parliament" means a day on which either House of Parliament sits.

(13) In the case of a resolution of both Houses of Parliament, the motion or amendment shall be referred to the House of Parliament in which it was first introduced, and the House of Parliament in which it was first introduced shall have the right to amend the motion or amendment.

(14) The House of Parliament in which a motion or amendment is first introduced shall have the right to amend the motion or amendment.

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
