

GENERAL MEETINGS.

XIX.—There shall be two general meetings of the Club, regularly every year, one on the second Wednesday of March for the purpose of electing the committee for the succeeding year, and receiving from the committee a report and abstract of the accounts and general concerns of the Club for the past year, together with an estimate of the receipts and disbursements of the current year. At this meeting members shall be at liberty to bring forward any subject having reference to the management and concerns of the Club. The other regular general meeting shall be held on the fourteenth day after the former, for the purpose of deciding on such propositions as may have been submitted at the first meeting. The chair shall be taken at all annual and special general meetings at eight o'clock p. m., precisely. The account of the Club shall be audited by an auditor not a member of the committee.
