

The Chaplain, or Brother appointed, shall say :

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.—*Rev. c. ii., v. 28.*

The Initiation Fee in this Order is not to be less than Two shillings and Sixpence, and not to exceed Five shillings.

In closing the Lodge, all the Brethren shall stand up, and raising their hands, (as in opening the Lodge,) the Chaplain, Master or Brother appointed, shall say the Lord's Prayer :

OUR FATHER, which art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth As it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive them that trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation ; But deliver us from evil ; For Thine is the kingdom, The power and the glory, For ever and ever, —*Amen.*

The Master shall then say :

I now declare this Loyal Purple Lodge closed in due form.
