

Belle River, Ont., Nov. 29.—At 6.10 this evening, fire broke out in Dr. Anderson's barn. The fire occurred in the stable end of a lantern, and spread very rapidly. Only for the rain that was falling at the time, the whole business part of the town would have been burned.

Are Afraid of the Competition in Their Line From America.

Paris, Nov. 29.—A deputation of the iron foundry Association, headed by Senator (London), waited to-day on the Minister of Commerce, with reference to the new Franco-American Treaty. At the time of the signing of the Franco-American competition would have on the iron industry of France, which, it was claimed, even under the general tariff, was seriously handicapped. The Minister replied, promising to carefully investigate the claims of the iron foundry.

Grand Trunk Conductor Could Not Be Seated for Test of the Evidence Furnished.

Stratford, Ont., Nov. 29.—The Bright manslaughter case was finally disposed of this evening when the Police Magistrate decided that there had not been sufficient evidence to warrant him sending Bright up for trial and he was accordingly discharged. Conductor Bright was charged with having caused, by his neglect, the death of two Stratford boys, who were stealing a ride on a train that met with an accident near St. Mary in September last.
