Schiff, Felix Warburg, Louis Marshall, Julius Rosen-wald, Dr. J. L. Magnes, Oscar Straus, and the Rev. Dr. Stephen S. Wise. A principal feature of the discussion will be the campaign to raise \$10,000,000 for the relief of three million starving Jews in the eastern war zone. Regarding the purposes of the conference Henry Mor-genthau said:

"Russia is the weak link in the international chain of which the United States is now a part. The new government must not be permitted to crumble or fall, and America has no more important work to do than the establishment of rock foundations under the re-volution. I favor the sending of America's railroad and industrial experts to Russia for the instant upbuilding of her transportation and manufacturers, to-gether with the necessary money and

supplies.

"Another great task is feeding and clothing the helpless Russian millions now dying of cold and hunger. American Jewry, in doing this work, will be serving the United States as well as saving their own people. As President Wilson said in his telegram thanking Julius Rosenwald for his million-dollar gift to Jewish war relief, "Every cent legrees democracy as well as humanity."
