NEWFOUNDLAND SHIPPING SUFFERED VERY HEAVILY

Within Six Months, Fifteen Vessels Have Gone Down and Three Are Missing—Twenty-Six Lives Are Lost

The winter has been an eventful one for Newfoundland and in no respect has the fact been brought home so forcibly as in the loss to the island's shipping. Within the six months from September 21, which would include the autumn gales and the winter's hurricanes, no fewer than fifteen vessels have gone to the bottom with a loss of twenty-six men, while three other ships are now reported missing in September: Crocker & Co. lost the Lady Napier, abandoned on the way to Brazil with a cargo of fish, and in December lost the Golden Hind, which sailed from St. John's on Oct. 10, and in December lost the Arctura in mid-ocean, while bound from Scotland, and the same month the Barks Joselyn and the Clara in mid-ocean, while returning from the Mediterranean, and Ryan & Baine Johnston's new steamer Rena is now overdue, the latter having on board as well as her own crew the men taken off the Arctura, and carried to London by a rescuing vessel.
