MAMORANDUM.

Optawa 26th September 1900-

Alonza Callon of Lot 51, River Rappe Onondaga, containing 123 acres for 5 years from 1st October 1900 at a yearly rental of \$225.00 for each of the first 2 years of the term and \$250.00 for each of the remaining 3 years payable as follows:- the rent for 1st year on 1st Nov. 1901 and thereafter half yearly on 15th days April and October in each year except the last payment which shall be made on 1st September 1905.

The Lessee to be allowed to prepare ground for fall wheat on execution of lease but not to occupy buildings until 1st Nov. The Locatee to supply all materials required for repairs to buildings or fences. The Lessee to leave seeded down at expiration of lease at least 25 acres in Timothy or Clover.

Bond to be given in double the amount of rent for the term.
