

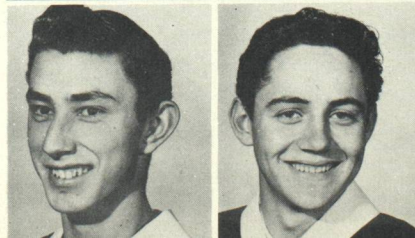
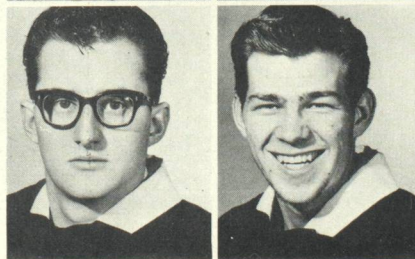
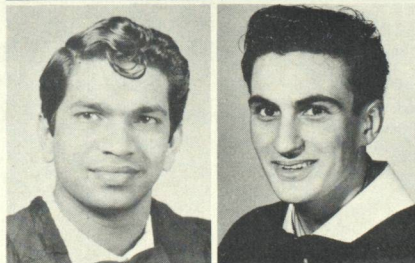
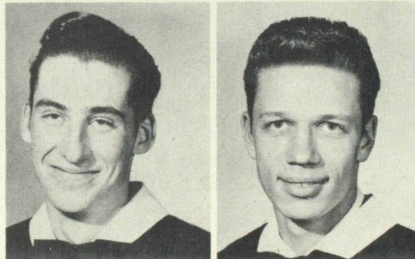
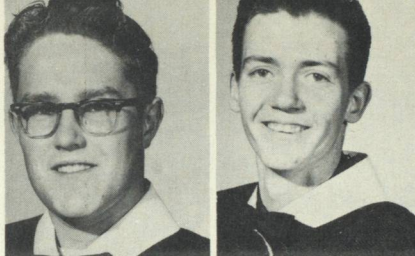
**Lynn Anderson:** Sorry, boys. I've got a straight flush again.
