FIRST SEDERUNT.

At the City of Toronto, and within Knox's Church, there, June 7, 1870, Tuesday, the seventh day of June, one thousand eight hundred ^{7,30} p.m. and seventy years, at half an hour after seven of the clock, in the evening, the which time and place the First General Assembly of the Canada Presbyterian Church met, in pursuance of an Act passed at a meeting of the Synod of the said Church, held in the City of Hamilton, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, entitled, "An Act for constituting a General Assembly and District Synods," and in pursuance of a resolution of the said Synod for averying the said Act into consolution of the said Synod for carrying the said Act into effect, which Act and resolu-tion are in terms following :---

AN ACT FOR CONSTITUTING A GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND DISTRICT SYNODS.

Whereas it is of importance, for the welfare and good govern- Act for ement of the Church, that a General Assembly and certain District attuting Synds should be instituted in the Canada Presbytrian Church-Genard as Be it, therefore, resolved and enacted, by and with the consent sensity of the Presbyteries, in terms of the Barrier Act, viz :----I. That, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy,

there shall be constituted a Supreme Court of this Church, instead of the present Synod, which shall be styled and entitled THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE CANADA PRESETTERIAN CHURCH,
