LONDON, May 20—(11 p.m.)—
Up to this hour there is no word of Hawker and his navigator, Grieve. Not a single report has been received from any of the numerous airplanes, destroyers, mine-sweepers and light craft of all descriptions which are sweeping the seas off the coast of Ireland. The task has been hampered by fog and rain.

In an official communique just issued, justifying the attitude of the Government in relation to the cross-Atlantic flight, which has ended in disaster, the admiralty warns the public that in view of the vast areas involved the chances of finding the airmen are very remote. The communique, referring to recent criticisms, says that the attitude of the air ministry has been to enjoin caution rather than to urge such attempts, and while anxious to do the utmost to save such gallant and fearless airmen as, Hawker and Grieve, the Government feels bound to warn those who may in the future attempt to fly the Atlantic that its resources make it utterly impossible that the immenses task of patrolling 2,000 miles of ocean can be undertaken.
