An Act respecting the Grand Valley Railway Company, and to change its name to "The Port Dover, Brantford, Berlin and Goderich Railway Company."

WHEREAS the Grand Valley Railway Company has, by Preamble. its petition, represented that it was incorporated by chapter 97 of the statutes of the Province of Ontario, of 1895, Ont., 1895, (amended by chapter 102 of the statutes of 1896), set forth in c. 97 5 the schedule to this Act, and has prayed that it be enacted as Ont., 1896, hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of c. 102. the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, declares and enacts as follows:-

10 1. In this Act the expression "the Company" means the Declaratory. body corporate and politic heretofore created by the Acts mentioned in the preamble under the name of "The Grand Valley Railway Company;" and the works which the Company by the said Acts and by this Act is empowered to undertake 15 and operate are hereby declared to be works for the general advantage of Canada.

2. Nothing herein contained shall affect anything done, or Rights under any right or privilege acquired, or any liability incurred un-provincial der the Acts mentioned in the preamble up to and at the time affected. 20 of the passing of this Act, to all of which rights and privileges the Company shall continue to be entitled and to all of which liabilities the Company shall continue to be subject, but hereafter the said works shall be subject to the legislative authority of the Parliament of Canada and the provisions of The Railway 25 Act.

3. The name of the Company is hereby changed from the Name Grand Valley Railway Company, to "The Port Dover, changed. Brantford, Berlin and Goderich Railway Company," but such Existing change in name shall not in any way impair, alter or affect the rights preserved. 30 rights or liabilities of the Company, nor in any wise affect any suit or proceeding now pending or judgment existing either by, or in favour of, or against the Company which, notwithstanding such change in the name of the Company may be prosecuted, continued, completed and enforced as if this Act 35 had not been passed.

4. The directors may, by by-law, change the place of the Head office. head office of the Company from the town of Berlin to the city of Brantford.
