Sir:

I have the honour to acquaint you that His Excellency Sir John Colborne has been pleased to sanction the erection at St Clair of a house for the Missionary to the Establishment and also a school house both to be completed before the winter sets in; & I have to desire that you will be pleased after consulting with Mr. Turner to forward to me plans of suitable Buildings of the above description & in the meantime to procure tenders for undertaking them which if you consider reasonable you may proceed with immediately, subject, as respects the dimensions of the Houses, to be modified on the plans being considered by His Excellency which are to be made with due regard to economy and the circumscribed means of the Department.
