In reply I have to inform you that in consequence of the state of transition in which business generally was placed owing to the resignation of the late and the formation of the present Government, attention could not be sooner given to this matter. Upon enquiry it is found has been ascertained that no vessel will leave Quebec for Nabaskowan this Fall.
