Camp Borden, Ont.	26-9-41.		<p>Station visited by Air Vice Marshall Croil, Inspector General. The Inspector - General was accompanied by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Air Commodore G.E. Brookes <u>OBE.</u>Group Captain P.E. Mackworth.Wing Commander D.F. Syder.F/L G.P. Dymond. <p>The party arrived by air at 0930 hours and proceeded on a tour of inspection accompanied by Group Captain R.S. Grandy <u>OBE.</u>, Wing Commander D.A.R. Bradshaw and F/L Badgley. At 1330 hours the personnel were inspected on the parade ground after forming into four squadrons-- Headquarters, Maintenance, No. 1 Squadron, No. 2 Squadron. The station band played during the inspection and was later inspected. Prior to the inspection a General Salute was given the Inspector General and held for the duration of the trumpet notes, about two minutes. After the inspection the I. G., and party took up a position near the ensign in front of Headquarters and the I.G. took the salute as the parade marched past. During the afternoon a conference was held in the C.C.'s office. A formal Mess Dinner was held at 1930 hours which was attended by the Officer personnel of the station, the I.G. and party, Sir Herbert Ames, and several officers of the C.A.S.F., including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Brigadier General G.E.
