Ottawa, 8th November, 1913.

Sir,-

I beg to inform you that you are hereby appointed on salary as medical attendant to the Indians of the Maria Reserve. Your salary will be at the rate of \$300.00 per annum to cover attendance and the cost of medicines. In return for this salary you will be expected to respond to all reasonable calls made upon your services by the Indians resident on the Reserve as well as visiting Indians, and also to attend in any cases which may be brought to your notice by the Indian Agent. You should give office attendance to Indians who may call upon you, and you will be expected to render your services in the case of epidemics without extra remuneration.

It is desired that you will submit a report regarding your Indian work at the close of each month on the forms, a supply of which will be sent you. The reports should be transmitted to the Department through the Indian Agent, the Rev. J. D. Morin, of Grand Cascapedia. For your information I enclose herewith copy of a circular letter on the subject of medical attendance which was issued in December 1912.
