- 28. Exchange of Progress Reports. Progress Reports were presented by the Service members and discussed by the Board.
- spent a day and a half visiting various establishments at Wright Field, including the Power Plant Laboratory, the Photographic Laboratory, the Equipment Laboratory, the Armament Laboratory and the 4140th AAF Research and Development Display Unit. The Board witnessed a flight line demonstration.

  The Board was impressed with the extraordinary achievement evident in all phases of technological research and development, the efficiency and organization of the establishment and the competence and morale of the personnel at the station. The activities at Wright Field constitute a major factor contributing to the security of the North American continent. The Canadian Section of the Board was particularly pleased to note that Canadian personnel were now participating in the research undertakings at Wright Field in accordance with the previous recommendations of the Board.
- 30. Next Meeting. The Board agreed to hold its next meeting at New York on September 11-12. The Board adjourned at 10:20 on Thursday, May 22.
