WHO SAITH:

On Friday, 26th Jan 45, about 2300 hrs on the corner of Rogge and Nationale Straten, I was attacked by 2 soldiers. One placed a pistol at my head and asked for my wallet which I gave to him. He also asked for the other money which I had in my pocket and my wristwatch. I gave the other money together with a fountain pen and said I had no watch. Afterwards they hit me on the chin.

I recognized several of my belonging (Photograph and passport wallet) in lot No. 4.
