

BY PROSECUTOR :- I offer this as evidence.

BY PRESIDENT :- Have you seen this, Mr. Frank?

BY DEFENDING OFFICER :- Yes, sir.

BY PRESIDENT :- Any objection?

BY DEFENDING OFFICER :- No, sir.

----- M.F.B. 375, dated 7 Nov 44, read to the Court, marked Exhibit "K", signed by the President, and att. to the proceedings.

BY PROSECUTOR : (resuming)

Q- I show you an M.F.M. 216. To whom does that refer?

A- Tpr. Lameront, B.V.

Q- That is.....

A- The accused.

BY PRESIDENT :- Any objection, Mr. Frank?

BY DEFENDING OFFICER :- No, sir.

----- M.F.M. 216, dated 24 Nov 44, read to the Court, marked Exhibit "L", signed by the President, and att. to the proceedings.

BY THE PROSECUTOR :- (resuming)

Q- Did the draft for which the accused was warned proceed?

A- The draft proceeded on the 10th of October, 1944.

Q- Was the accused present at that time?

A- No.

Q- Was he absent?

A- Yes.

Q- Did he have leave?

A- Without leave.

CROSS-EXAMINED BY THE DEFENDING OFFICER :-
