Reference your letter dated August 5th, 1946, file number 5008-B21-17.

A thorough examination of the engine in CF-EUQ was made including the oil screens, fuel lines, fuel tank, and carburator, no mechanical failure or foreign matter could be found.

It is of our opinion that the pilot failed to put the gas shut off cock in the full "on" position this has happened in other cases which allows the aircraft to gain an altitude of several hundred feet before the engine becomes starved of fuel causing engine failure. May this report meet with your approval.
