## RULES OF ORDER.

Rule 1-At cevery sitting, business shall be opened and concluded with prayer.

Rule 2.-Ministers and members of Churches, not Delegates, invited to a seat with us, may speak on all subjects under debat", but vote on none.

Rule. 3.-No member of the Convertion shall absent himself without leave of the Moderator.

Rule. 4-The names of Delegates leaving the Convention without permission of the body before the conclusion of the business shall be publicly reported in the Minutes.

Rule 5.-No object shall be discussed without a motion first made and seconded.

Rule 6.-No person shall speak oftener than twice on any motion unless by permission of the body.

Rule 7.- Motions made and lost shall not be recorded on the Minutes except so ordered at the time.

Ruies 8.- The Moderator of the Convention shall nominate all Committees, unless otherwise ordered by the Convention.

Rule 9.-These Rules shall be distinctly read fiom the Chair immediately after the opening of the Convention.
