

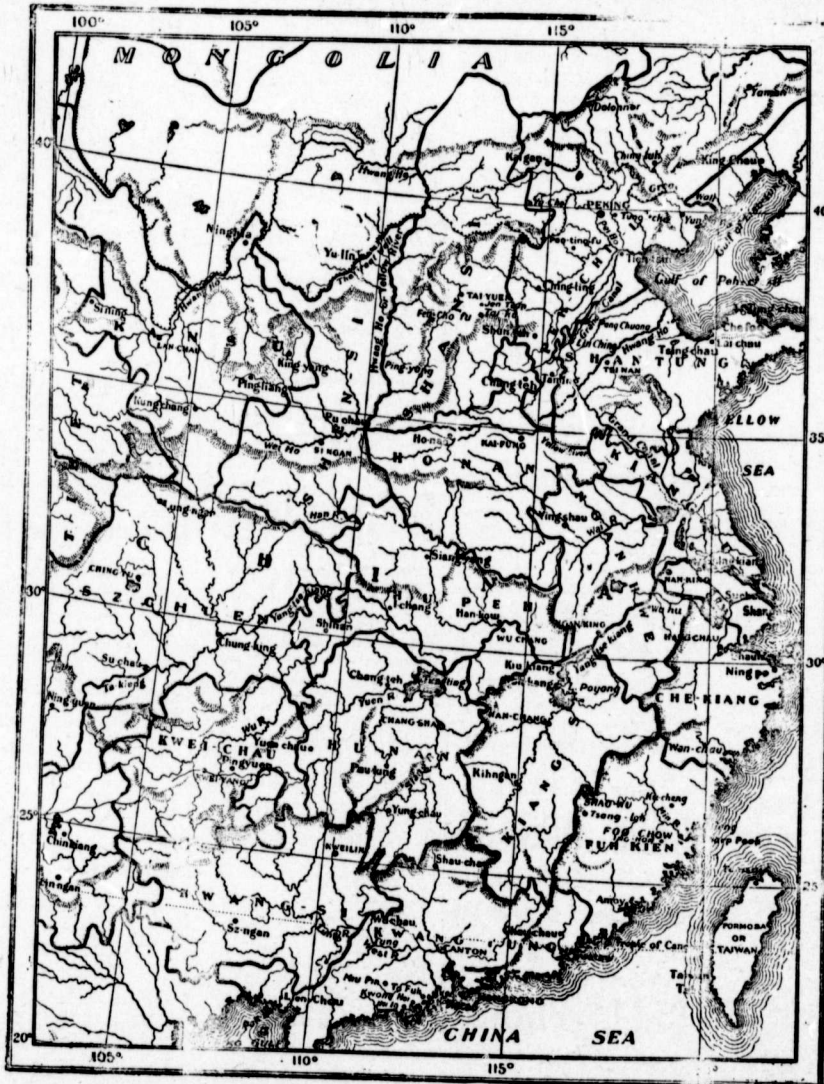

This very clear and detailed map of China on which the boundaries of the eighteen-provinces, the capitals, chief towns, canals, rivers and chief mountain ranges are plainly marked, is worth preserving for reference during the present troubles. A northern Province of Chihli or Peh-chili, are clearly marked. The Gulf of Peh-chili is traversed by the dispatch boats of the fleets carrying reports from Tientsin to Chifu. Chifu, in Shantung Province, an open port, where the admiralty ships of the foreign navies are stationed, and from whence comes most of our news, is the Chefoo shown on the map—a merely different spelling of the same name. Nanking, the capital of Kiangnan, principality, on the Yangtse river, is in the Province of Kiangsu, on the coast of the Yellow Sea, and Shanghai, the paradise of the news fakirs, is on the coast, in the same province. Canton, the capital of the principality of Liangkwo, whose viceroy is Li Hung Chang, is on the West river, in the province of Kwungtung, and Hongkong, the British seaport, is just off the coast of the same province, at the mouth of the river.
