Denver, Colo., January 19.—(Buffalo
Bill) William Frederick Cody (Buffalo
Bill), soldier, hunter, and scout, died at
12:05 P.M. here to-day, at the home of his
sister.

With Colonel Cody when he died were
his wife and daughter, who had been
down from Cody, Wyo., the family home,
last week, to be at his bedside, and his
sister, Mrs. L. E. Decker, of Denver.
