Rev. Dr. Warden of Toronto has been elected Moderator of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian church, Rev. Dr. Pollock retiring.

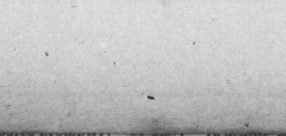
