Synopsis of Coal Mining! Regulations.

Coal mining right of the Dominion in Manitoba, Baskatchewan and Alerta, the Yukon Territory, the North-west Territories and in a portion of the Province of British Columbia may be leased for a term of twenty-one years at an annual rental of \$1. an acre. Not more than 2,560 acres will be leased to one applicant.

Applications for a lease must be made by the applicant in person to the Agent or Subtagent in the district in which the rights applied for

In surveyed territory the land must be described by sections, or legal sub-divisions of sections, and in un surveyed territory the tract applied for shall be staked out by the appli-

Hach application must be accompanied by a fee of 55 which will be refunded if the rights applied for are not available, but not otherwise. A royalty shall be paid on the merchantable output of the mine at the rate of five cents per ton.

The person operating the mine shall furnish the agent with sworn returns accounting for the full quantity of accountable coal mined and pay the royalty thereon. If the coal mining rights are not being operated, such returns should be furnished at least

once a year. The lease will include the coal mining rights only, but the lessee may permitted to purchase whatever vallable surface rights may be conidered necessary for the working of the mine at the rate of \$10.00 an


