APRIL FARM NOTES.

A well started crop is usually profitable, and one put in late or under unfavorable conditions is seldom satisfactory. Harvesting winter grain is a practice that is now quite generally adopted by the better farmers.

Beets, including mangels, may be sown the last of the month. Quick starting of the seeds may be insured by soaking them. They should be sown as soon as germination begins.

Grass is a leading farm crop, and is much neglected. Our farmers have given very little attention to the study of grass and the soils and culture best adapted to the various sorts.

Put all farm implements in good order during rainy days. Clear up the rubbish that has accumulated. Look well to fences before cattle are turned out.

The care bestowed on sheep by some farmers during the winter, invites weakness, and a troublesome irritation of the skin and loss of wool after poor treatment.
