QUEBEC, Que., June 6.—By Grattan O'Leary, Staff Correspondent of the Canadian Press, Limited.—With his first parliamentary session as prime minister over, Rt. Hon. The conference of prime ministers, which opens within the historic precincts of No. 1D Downing street, on June 21, is the first of its kind to be held in the empires history.
